What is Amateur Radio?

- A licensed service OK'd by FCC to let the public use radio transceivers to communicate around the world (other countries have licenses also)
- Set of radio frequencies set aside for amateur use from 1MHz – 300GHz <u>for free</u>
- Ability to communicate very long distances with no infrastructure and minimal equipment
- Help in emergencies or disaster relief or rural areas
- A way for people interested in electronics to put their talents to good use!

Emergency Communications, Storm Tracking, rapid deployment w/ no infrastructure, long distance communication for rural areas








Hobby build radios, antennas, filters, tuners, matching

Becoming a Ham Radio Operator

- You need to take a test in order to have a radio license
- Three levels (tech, general, extra) in increasing difficulty but you get more bandwidth and privileges
- Database of all questions and answers published online
- AUARC is licensed to give the test anytime
- We have test study books, or hamstudy.org
- For EE's, tech test is a breeze
- License not required to be in K4RY
